Thank you for your interest in attending an Airgunning Atlanta airgun field target event.

AA is a member club of the American Airgun Field Target Association (AAFTA). All local and regional matches utilize AAFTA match guidelines. AA hosted the 1999 Georgia Southern Regionals, the 2000 Georgia State Championships, and the 2001 AAFTA National Championships these past few years. We hope to bring the WFTA World Field Target Championships to Atlanta in the future.

AA has a regular Field Target match every other Saturday each month. We welcome you to join us in Covington, Georgia to participate in one of our local competitions. Your first visit is free and we will even try to supply you with an air rifle and pellets for the match if you don't have one already. Just contact us first and let us know how we can help you out. Since some Saturdays are inconvenient for some, we also host alternate weekend dates to accommodate our membership.

We do ask that if you bring your own airgun, please insure that it is rated at 20 foot pounds or less and that it is in safe working order. Lead pellet ammunition only will be allowed due to safety concerns with ricochets. The higher power airguns (over 20fpe) tend to damage our metal field targets, but you are welcome to shoot our paper targets with any power of airgun.

Directions to match site:

- Travel I-20 East to Exit 93 (Hazelbrand), turn right on Hazelbrand.
- After 1 mile, turn left on Hwy 278. (first major intersection)
- Drive approximately 2.3 miles and bear right on Hwy 142. (after the bridge)
- Drive approximately 3.5 miles, turn right on Woodlawn Road (just after the 4J Arena sign)
- Drive approximately 0.5 miles to 1865 Woodlawn (on right).
- Proceed through wooden gate and bear left on dirt road past travel trailer.
- Travel down dirt road, through wooded area for approximately 200 yards.
- At open field (sight-in range), park anywhere.

Monthly Saturday matches start a 10:00 AM with a paper target sight-in time between 8:30 –10:00 AM. The field target course is comprised of 27 to 30 targets spread over 12 to 16 shooting lanes. This results in a normal 54 to 60 shot match.

AA has developed a web site (www.morphire.com) with information such as Field Target Q&A, regional and national match schedules, a picture gallery, and extensive links to other airgun websites. Monthly AA local match results are posted on this web site along with results from Regional and National matches.
